


ICONOGRAPHIC KEY BASED ON CUEVAS GARCÍA (2007:FIG. 86)




This element is identified as TC-1/97 in the definitive treatise on the effigy incensarios of Palenque by Martha Cuevas García (2007:Fig. 160). Cuevas attributes it to temporal Phase III and identifies the effigy as that of GIII in the form of the Jaguar Paddler (Cuevas García 2007:Fig. 160).




TC-2/97 pertains to Phase IV and depicts GI of the Palenque Triad (Cuevas García 2007:Fig. 163).



TC-3/97 dates to Phase IV and depicts GIII of the Palenque Triad in the form of the Stingray Paddler (Cuevas García 2007:Fig. 166).



TC-4/97, from Phase III, portrays GIII in the form of the Stingray Paddler (Cuevas García 2007:Fig. 158).




TC-5/97 dates to Phase III and depicts GIII in the guise of the Jaguar Paddler (Cuevas García 2007:Fig. 160).



Element 10, Palenque, Mexico


Plan: 0 10 cm

TC-10/98 is from Phase III and shows GI of the Palenque Triad (Cuevas García 2007:Fig. 157).




Element 11, Palenque, Mexico

TC-11/98, from Phase III, depicts the Stingray Paddler form of GIII (Cuevas García 2007:Fig. 159).





TC-14/98 dates to Phase III and portrays GIII as the Jaguar Paddler (Cuevas García 2007:Fig. 162).




